The program meets three days a week, Mondays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays, from 10 AM-3 PM, at Temple Sholom, Scotch Plains, NJ. The cost of the program is \$80 per day with subsidies available for Union County residents who qualify. The program provides an opportunity to use and strengthen physical and cognitive abilities and skills, increase self-esteem, and offers an opportunity to be social and have fun.

Entertainment, exercise, snacks, lunch and transportation are provided by professional staff three times a week, Mondays, Wednesdays and Thursdays, from 10 a.m.-3 p.m. at Temple Sholom, 1925 Lake Avenue, Scotch Plains, New Jersey.

A free monthly concert for the participant and caregiver is offered through a 2023 HEART (History Education Arts Reaching Thousands) grant from the Union County Board of County Commissioners.
